In 2024-2025, we streamlined the HEDS Alumni Survey for Advance Degree Students to make it shorter and reduce drop-out. The survey went from 38 to 30 questions, and the time to take it reduced from ~15 minutes to ~10 minutes. In the following pages, we outline the changes from the original survey to the 2024-2025 survey.
